**Eligibility:**

Uninsured, Live in Miami-Dade County, Income at or below 200% Federal Poverty Level.

**Registration: Only by telephone.** Call 305-635-1335 for information on registration process.

**Minors:**

Children under the age of 18 must be registered by a parent or legal guardian. A parent or legal guardian must accompany all minors to all appointments.


**Documents Needed:**

1. Proof that you live in Miami-Dade - Example: bills such as phone, electricity, car registration or other document that has your name and address that you have received through postal mail in the last 60 days.
2. Picture ID - Example: driver’s license, passport or other picture ID
3. Proof of income for **each member of the family unit:**

If you are paid by check	Paystubs from the last 4 weeks.
If you are paid in cash	Letter describing your job and stating the amount earned the last 4 weeks, <b>you must use format provided by the clinic</b> you can request by mail, fax, email or you may download it at <a href="http://stjohnboscoclinicmiami.org">stjohnboscoclinicmiami.org</a> <b>Or</b> *Letter on your employer’s letterhead, signed by employer stating how much you make per month.
If you are unemployed	Letter stating that you are currently unemployed. <b>you must use format provided by the clinic</b> you request it by mail, fax, email or you may download it at <a href="http://stjohnboscoclinicmiami.org">stjohnboscoclinicmiami.org</a>
If you are retired	Retired individuals must provide the most current year official Social Security income statement and documented lack of Medicare and/or Medicaid. Private retirement plans statement of benefits.

**Family Unit:**

- One or more persons living in the same house who are related by blood, marriage, law (adoption, legal custody), conception, or who are cohabitating partners. But if they are:
  - A single adult, 18 and over, living with relatives but not related by blood, marriage, law (adoption, legal custody), conception, or who are cohabitating partners then they are considered a separate family for income determination purposes. **Exception:** A student, age 18-21, living at home, shall be considered a family member. If the student 18-21 is working, proof of income has to be provided. If the student 18-21 is unemployed, notarized unemployment letter has to be provided.
